Sexuality with high honors from U.C. Berkeley, has written about intersex in *The Advocate*, *Ms.*, *The Global Herald*, CNN.com, the *American Journal of Bioethics*, and others, and has been a guest on numerous television shows including *20/20* and *Oprah*. On December 10, 2013, she became the first openly intersex person to speak at the United Nations, for their Human Rights Day event *Sport Comes Out Against Homophobia*, with Martina Navratilova, Jason Collins, and others.
